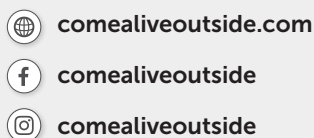

Oatmeal Apple Cauldrons

- Assemble the Cauldrons! - (Apple Bowls) Remove the cores from 4 apples and hollow out leaving the bottoms intact. Your cauldrons should have a 1-2in diameter.
- Build your Potion! - (Filling) In a medium bowl, stir together 1 cup rolled oats, 1/4 cup brown sugar, and 1/2tsp - 1tsp cinnamon (optional).
- Stir in 1/4 cup butter until potion is thoroughly mixed!
- Fill cauldrons with your potion mix and bake at 350 until tender and potion is light brown (about 30 min).

Stuffed Jack-O'-Lanterns

- Hollow out orange bell peppers and carve little jack-o'-lantern faces.
- Fill with a savory mix of Vermont sausage (or ground local venison), rice, onions, and fall veggies like kale or carrots.
- Bake until peppers are tender and the filling is bubbling.

Emerald Lake Cemetery (East Dorset): Hidden in the state park with 1800s settlers' graves



Whipple Hollow Cemetery (Florence): Linked to a vanished settlement & schoolhouse



Evergreen Cemetery (Rutland): 1861 garden-style cemetery with marble monuments



East Poultney Jewish Cemetery (Poultney): VT's oldest Jewish cemetery with beautiful headstones carved in Yiddish & Hebrew



West Street Cemetery (Fair Haven): 1700s slate stones & Revolutionary War soldiers
