





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Hubbardton Battlefield Trail

5696 Monument Hill Road
Hubbardton, VT

.5 Miles

This is the location of the only Revolutionary War fought in VT. Check out the Monument.



Calvary Cemetery

150 Meadow Street, Rutland, VT

.25 Miles

Calvary Cemetery becomes a quiet winter landscape where you can spot the historic stonework that marks some of Rutland's earliest immigrant families.



Whipple Hollow Trails

3600 Whipple Hollow Road
West Rutland, VT

.25 Miles

A magical boardwalk trail through one of Vermont's few true Northern White Cedar swamps.



West Rutland Marsh

Water St, West Rutland, VT

.2 Miles

 **Wheelchair Accessible**

Winter reveals the marsh's secrets: clearer views of the landscape, fresh animal signs, and the peaceful beauty of a frozen wetland at rest.



Thundering Brook Falls

2295 River Rd Fork, Killington, VT

.5 Miles

 **Wheelchair Accessible**

This trail includes one of VT's tallest waterfalls cascading 125-140 feet which you can admire from one of VT's oldest accessible boardwalk trails.



The Tamarack Notch Trail

Notch Rd, Mendon VT

.5 Miles

Located in The Aitken State Forest, this trail follows an old loop road that was part of the Civilian Conservation Corps camp and later a Girl Scout Camp.

Sugar On Snow

Sugar on the snow is a fun winter treat! Collect clean snow in a bowl and keep it cold. Heat pure maple syrup in a pot until bubbly (grown-ups should help with this part). Ingredients

- A snowy spread: cream cheese or Greek yogurt*
- Rice cakes


